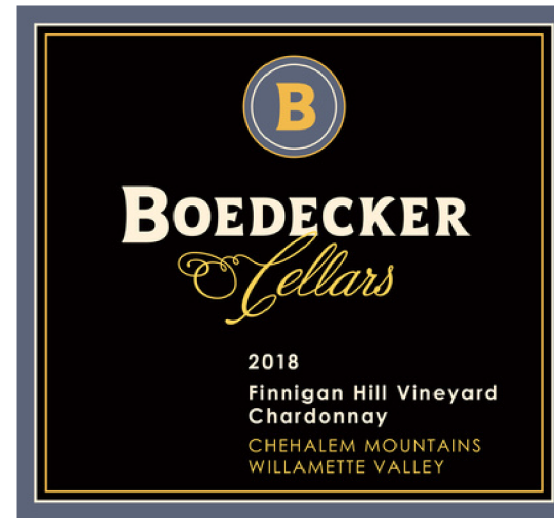

Finnigan Hill Vineyard - Chehalem Mountains, Willamette Valley. Elevation: 800 ft, clone 95, east facing, planted in 2007, Laurelwood over Jory soil.
